



Memorandum of Understanding

This AGREEMENT is made by and between the Korean Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons (KSPRS) and the German Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery (DGPRÄEC).

Now, it is hereby agreed as follows.

ARTICLE 1.

This AGREEMENT is made for the following purposes:

- 1) Acknowledgement of a spirit of cooperation and mutual benefit.
- 2) Maintaining the highest principles of surgical practice and professional ethics.
- 3) Promotion of exchanges and friendship of the members of KSPRS and DGPRÄEC.
- 4) Encouraging each society's active members and trainees to attend the annual meeting of the both societies.
- 5) Providing benefits to members and trainees of the other society who participate in the annual meeting and educational activities
- 6) Collaboration in patient education and awareness campaigns

ARTICLE 2.

In order to achieve the purposes under ARTICLE 1, the both societies shall continue to cooperate with each other sincerely.

ARTICLE 3.

The intention of this AGREEMENT is to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration, and will not prejudice or affect the rights of the both societies to form agreements with others.

This AGREEMENT is for an initial term of (1) year from the date of signing. The AGREEMENT will automatically renew for subsequent years unless one of the societies

decides to terminate. The AGREEMENT can be terminated with ninety-days advance written notice to the other society.


*This AGREEMENT shall become effective on November 18, 2024.








