## ABOUT ISAPS RESIDENT FAST-TRACK MEMBERSHIP

ISAPS offers ISAPS Resident Junior membership free of charge, offering access to our bespoke monthly resident-only training and online access to our Journal and extensive video library. ISAPS Global Alliance Partners are eligible and invited to propose their members in training for ISAPS Group Fast-Track Resident membership.

Residents who are proposed by member societies of the Global Alliance Partnership do not have to complete the ISAPS membership applications and approvals process: they will be automatically admitted to ISAPS membership.



### WHAT DO GLOBAL ALLIANCE PARTNERSHIP SOCIETIES HAVE TO DO?

1. Before proposing resident members to ISAPS, Global Alliance Partnership members sign a short Memorandum of Understanding. This will form an agreement between your Society and ISAPS, stating that you:
  - are happy for us to accept the residents that you propose as ISAPS Resident members.
  - are confident that the members you propose are, to the best of your knowledge, currently undertaking a plastic surgery residency.
  - will gain permission from the residents that you propose to share basic contact details with ISAPS for the purpose of fulfilling their membership (this is legally necessary for Data Protection reasons).
2. Global Alliance Partnership members must send us an Excel spreadsheet containing the following information for the residents being proposed for group membership under this agreement:
  - First name and last name
  - Contact email address
  - Date of anticipated residency completion
  - Start date of residency

### WHAT WILL ISAPS DO?

1. Add the name, contact email address and date of completion of their residency program to the ISAPS membership database and automatically validate the membership status.
2. Send the residents an email message, confirming that they have been added to the ISAPS Resident Junior membership and inviting them to create a personalized password to access the full suite of member resources available to them.
3. Ask the residents to complete further personal details (address, etc.) on their ISAPS Member Profile.
4. ISAPS will not charge residents application or joining fees. However, they will be offered the option to purchase payable services or activities for residents (e.g. subscription to ISAPS MedOne).
5. After three years, or the date their residency is completed, whichever is sooner, residents will be offered the chance to continue their membership at ISAPS' lowest cost levels. No payments or inclusions will be automatic.

The organizations hereby agree to collaborate to further their shared goals to promote and provide the highest quality education in aesthetic plastic surgery by facilitating access for residents in Germany to ISAPS free education and training for residents.

## **Background**

ISAPS offers Resident membership to surgeons who are currently and actively participating in a plastic surgery training / residency program. The "ISAPS Resident Junior" membership is free of charge for three years, and gives residents free access to ISAPS residency program: including ISAPS fellowships, bespoke resident only monthly resident's webinars / meet the expert sessions, and full access to our Journal Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (online) and extensive video library. They can also choose to subscribe to ISAPS MedOne residents training resource for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery at the lowest available prices.

## **Free ISAPS Membership & group recognition of Residency status offer**

For Global Alliance Partners who are able to confirm their own residents' status through training records or validation, ISAPS is able to offer fast-track group resident membership to ALL resident members of the partner organisation.

Under the terms of this agreement, residents who are proposed by the partner society as eligible for ISAPS residents' junior membership and (provided eligibility criteria are met and all required information is provided to ISAPS for fulfilment purposes) shall be automatically admitted as ISAPS members without going through the individual application and approval process.

The Partner Society agrees to promote ISAPS membership to its resident members and to seek any necessary consents for sharing of contact data for the purpose of fulfilling this offer.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING: ISAPS GROUP RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP

### **Conditions of the Agreement**

#### *Rights and confidentiality*

Any agreed projects, events and programs shall not be exclusive i.e. neither party is restricted from opportunities for similar arrangements with other organizations towards the independent organizations' goals or the shared goals of this agreement.

The parties agree to transparent sharing of relevant information between them as required to facilitate this agreement, in line with the prevailing data protection regulations (including GDPR).

All proprietary information provided in the course of this agreement shall remain as such to the party so providing it and be treated as confidential as required and as requested. Under no circumstances shall either party share information of the other party whatsoever without explicit pre-agreement.

#### *Promotion and Branding*

ISAPS authorises the partner Society to use its brand solely for the purposes described to list and promote ISAPS Resident's program to its members, on its website and other media. ISAPS will promote the Global Alliance Partner as a residency program partner on its website. The partner society agrees to seek approval from ISAPS for use of its logo in any other promotional items bearing their name and/or logo before making them public.

#### *Financial terms*

The purpose of this MoU is not for financial gain but for mutual support and promotion of the parties mutual objectives.

Unless specifically and otherwise agreed in relation to any individual project requested or specified, where the terms will be separately outlined, there are no charges or payments to the Global Alliance Partnership to participate in the ISAPS Group Residency Agreement, as described. Each party remains otherwise responsible entirely for the finances of their respective membership management projects and programs.

#### *Modification of the MoU*

Any modifications to this MoU must be agreed upon by both parties and in writing.

#### *Duration of the Agreement*

This MoU will become effective immediately after its approval and applies until the concluded by written notification, duly signed by the presiding officer of the notifying party, giving at least 28 days' notice.

## Agreement

**DGPRÄC** \_\_\_\_\_ hereby understands and agrees:

1. To participate in the ISAPS Global Alliance residency partnership as described and in line with the terms outlined in this MoU, and to offer ISAPS membership to all its eligible resident members
2. That ISAPS may admit those residents proposed under this scheme as ISAPS Resident Junior members.
3. That free ISAPS Resident Junior membership lasts for three years, free of charge, irrespective of the length of the residency program, after which time Residents will be contacted to decide if they wish to remain as a resident member at nominal cost.
4. That resident names and residency details provided under the terms of this agreement will be subject to reasonable due diligence such that they are, to the best of the Society's ability and knowledge, known to be currently undertaking a plastic surgery residency.
5. To ensure appropriate permissions from the residents whose details are shared for the purposes of this program in advance of sharing their details, such data for the time being to include: Name, email contact, date of commencement of residency, estimated date of completion of residency / training.
